ANS: The baptism of Jesus Christ (only of water) was an anointing in the Holy Spirit as a preparation for his public ministry. This was a response to the preaching of John the Baptist. But let us not forget that Jesus was circumcised when he was an infant and thus became a Jew. In the Catholic Church, we are baptised in Spirit which removes the stain of original sin (Romans 5:12) from our souls as early as possible. Thus, an infant is made holy, anointed with the Holy Spirit and becomes part of the Church (CCC 1250). In fact Jesus calls infants to himself and says the Kingdom of God belongs to them in Luke 18:15-17. Later, during the sacrament of Confirmation one affirms with reason and understanding one's own faith ◦
