

#### SHEPHERD'S STORY



Y mother played a huge role in my faith formation. Being the youngest, she loved me a lot and singled me out to accompany her to church and for all other faith-related activities. She would encourage me to do the readings well in church. If it was a holiday, she would encourage me to attend a second Mass that day. Though she never told me directly, she wished for me to be a priest.

Whenever she spoke about priests, she would say that priesthood was not about receiving from others. It was about giving oneself to others.

She would often talk about the boy who gave his loaves to Jesus. His mother would have probably given them to him. But when Jesus asked for something to eat, none of the adults gave anything. It was this boy who gave his loaves to Jesus. That kind of giving is what priesthood is about, she would tell us.

THOUGH SHE **NEVER TOLD ME DIRECTLY. SHE WISHED FOR ME** TO BE A PRIEST. WHENEVER SHE **SPOKE ABOUT** PRIESTS, SHE **WOULD SAY THAT PRIEST-HOOD WAS NOT ABOUT RE-CEIVING FROM** OTHERS. IT WAS **ABOUT GIVING ONESELF TO** OTHERS.

I remember my first vocation camp my first time away from home – so my mother packed warm clothes for me. There, the boy on the bed next to mine had acute asthma. He developed a high fever and was severely breathless. As my older brother had the same problem, I felt sympathy for the bou. I gave him my warm blanket and tried to make him comfortable. Then I went and told the priest in charge, who told me to take care of the bou.

Later, I entered the seminary and soon I kept getting 'looks' from people, especially my seniors. On enquiring, I was told that the camp fathers had used me as an example. They told the seniors that I was a boy with hardly any formation yet my example was one to follow. That vocation was about giving.

In those days, there were no hospitals in rural areas except in town, where we lived. Whenever any of our dear ones came to the hospital, my mother would make it a point to send them food. When I would ask her about it, she would just make me go and deliver the food to them.

In my 40 years as a priest my motto - having been drilled into my head in childhood – has been, 'to be broken, to be aiven'

# Basilica of Our Lady of Guadalupe

ILLIONS OF PILGRIMS from around the world come to see the Basilica of Our Lady of Guadalupe.

This church was inspired by Mother Mary, and is a symbol of our faith.

It all started on a cold winter's day. St. Juan Diego was an Aztec, who converted and became a devout Catholic. On December 9th, 1531, Juan Diego was going to Mass as usual. As he walked past Tepeyac Hill, he saw a vision of Our Lady. Our Lady asked Juan Diego to visit the local bishop and tell him to build a shrine for her. He hurried to convey the news but the bishop didn't believe him and asked for proof that Mary appeared to him.

A helpless Juan Diego went back home to take care of his sick uncle. On December 12th, as he went looking for a priest who would give the last sacrament to his uncle, Our Lady appeared to him again. He told her of the bishop's answer, and she reassured him and healed his uncle. She told him that he would find roses on the hill, even

though it was winter which would be the proof the bishop wanted. Juan Diego found the roses and gathered them in his *tilma* (cloak). When he opened his cloak, the roses fell out and the bishop saw an image of Our Lady imprinted inside the cloak. The bishop believed Juan Diego, and very soon, a shrine to Our Lady was built.

The original *tilma* with Our Lady's image is enshrined in the altar of the basilica. After centuries of remodelling, and extensive damage to the church, a new basilica was built, which is what we see today.



#### **SOME FACTS**

- t is the most visited Marian site in the world.
- The feast of Our Lady of Guadalupe is 12th of December.
- The new Basilica has a circular floorplan so that the image of the Virgin can be seen from any

point within the building.

- The exterior represents the Virgin's mantle that 'covers' those who come to visit her.
- In 1921, a factory worker planted a bomb a few feet away from the *tilma*. The explosion demolished the marble steps of the main altar, the windows of nearby homes and it bent a brass crucifix, but the *tilma* suffered no damage.





# Sharing esty

ELLO! MY NAME IS ANTHONY JOSEPH and I am currently in the 9<sup>th</sup> grade. When I was asked to write this article, I was filled with tension. 'What am I going to write for the whole world to read?' I asked myself. 'What if my article doesn't make sense?' Then I realised that what I wrote about Jesus was me spreading Jesus to the world. 




Jesus told them a story about a farmer who went out to sow seeds.

# Peas, a monk and the Catholic Church

ave you ever wondered whether you look more like your father or your mother or a little bit of both? Your friends or relatives may have remarked about it.

People study these aspects in a field of science known as genetics. It helps us find out from whom we got those lovely eyes, pretty hair or our height. We can also study these features in plants. Will the plant be tall or short? What colour flowers will they produce?

There was a Catholic monk a really long time ago in the 18th century. His name was Fr Gregor Mendel. He was interested in studying genetics in plants, especially pea plants. He saw that the pea plants sometimes produced yellow peas and sometimes produced green peas! Sometimes they were short and sometimes they were tall! So, he decided to find out what was happening. He studied 29,000 pea plants to figure out when you could get a particular combination!

That's a lot of work, isn't it? By the grace of God and his hard work, he figured it out. He is called the Father of Modern


Genetics. The whole world still follows his observations to study genetics till date!

Are you wondering how a monk was involved in the field of science? As Catholics, are we allowed to do experiments in science? The answer is YES! The secrets of science are revealed to us by God through our efforts to understand his creation. The Church supports science as long as our work is in line with our faith and morals. So, the next time you want to know why a plant is short or why you have brown eyes, you know you can use science to try and figure it out!

### DARE TO BE SAINTS







### **MATERIALS REQUIRED**

- Drawing paper/cardboard or any thick sheet of paper (avoid regular print paper as it will become soggy)
- Water colours, brushes, rag, water and palette
- White glue tube (with nozzle)
- Salt
- Rice (optional)



#### **PROCEDURE**

- On the drawing paper, write the name of Jesus in any writing style and in any language.
- You may add a design like little hearts and stars, big heart, crown of thorns etc. along with the name.
- Outline the drawing with white glue.
- Sprinkle salt and completely cover the glued portion. Make sure you do it immediately after you have finished outlining with glue.
- Let it dry for a few hours.
   24 hours would be good,
   we can learn patience
   from this too.
- After it is dry, remove the excess salt and you will see the design.
- Now taking some water colour, slowly touch a part of the design. You will see the colour spreading.
- Keep repeating this, until the entire design is filled with colour. Use different colours to paint the name of Jesus.





















- Optional If you live in a very humid place, sprinkle some rice over the salt.
   This will absorb the moisture from salt and prevent the paper from becoming wet
- If the paint falls on the paper, use a fresh brush to put some water and wipe gently with a clean cloth.
- Use a flat surface to do the activity.
- Use a brush to dust out and remove excess salt from the edges of the design before applying paint.

The child smiles. The vision settles and their souls rejoice. They fall on their knees and sing.



For instance, submission of a project/ exam times; a get-together at home...The first one - old style, catch hold of your ears (not listening you see) and twist a bit, it helps - ZIMPLE. Believe me, it does. And if not, ask an elder at home to do it for you... ha ha ha....

How? through these 5 Ps:

### Teaching Kids to be Considerate

MPATHY, COMPASSION and going out of our way to help others are godly characters that mark a true Christian. We need to consciously try to instill these virtues in children, as it is not something that comes naturally to them. I will share my insights, as well as few things we try to do in our family.

Firstly, kids need to understand their value as God's unique creation and the dignity that accompanies this. We need to teach them that all people are created in the image of God, are equally valued in God's eyes, and all have equal dignity. This will help them to embrace

the fact that they are not greater than those who seem less fortunate or less smart than them, and to serve others with a humble heart.

One of the reasons kids tend to be selfcentered is because they lack nothing. Most parents tend to overindulge their kids with everything

they want or ask for. As parents, we have a responsibility to provide for their 'needs'. But providing for every 'want' is a means to spoiling them and teaching them to be selfish. More than things, what kids need from us is our time and presence. We as parents must make it a priority to spend time with our children, as our presence and all the positive impacts it can make, will last a lifetime.

Sometimes parents also tend to overprotect their children, as they do not want them to fail. But kids need to fail within safe boundaries. If they make a mistake or a bad choice, we must let them own up to it, instead of protecting them. By developing a culture of taking responsibility for their actions, they learn to watch out for others and become more considerate.

Most importantly, all these should be capped off with personal prayer and teaching our children to pray for others. Through personal prayer, they learn to understand their own dignity as a child of God. By praying for others, they learn to step into the other person's shoes, understand their needs, empathise with them and lift them up to God.

By teaching them to serve and be considerate of others, we are teaching to be good Christians.



- Model good behaviour and genuine concern for others. Kids quickly pick up whatever
- Encourage kids to play cooperatively. Through cooperative play, they build team-spirit and learn to look out for each other.
- ⇔ Have them apologise where needed. Even if something was not done on purpose, they should make it a point to say

- sorry, and to see how they can make up for it.
- **♥** Whenever they see someone in distress, have them check what that person needs, and try to console them.
- Teach them to let others go first.
- Have them try to clean up their own mess, instead of leaving it for others.
- Develop a habit of personal prayer and praying for others. •


- Establish routines to wake up, eat, play, study, sleep, etc.

- It's OK to not be OK. You do not have to struggle in silence. Feel free to share your concerns with a mental health professional, if needed o


